Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They started out as a small machine shop initially hiring four people. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and different parts. Throughout five years of operation, the company had stretched to forty workers and their annual sales volume had risen to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is one of the leading global manufacturers within the material handling trade.

Manufacture and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of better business opportunities. Over the past 60 years, the material handling business has developed into a highly sophisticated area and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this development. Cascade presently continues to develop as the leader provider of lift truck accessories and different related items. The company feels certain in their ability to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the world market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to make, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was constructed in 1956, to accommodate all plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's present center of operations. After fifteen years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached nearly two million three hundred thousand dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Tacoma a second manufacturing plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants within the U.S. with locations in Springfield, Tacoma, Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are manufactured globally thanks to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 after acquiring 5 firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in blades.
