

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the blade carriage lifting capacity, there are four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

Pin mounted blades differ by the amount of offset between the fork and the fork eye. Different manufacturers will vary the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
